Program Description

The program is funded through a 1% surcharge on the gross receipts collected from Connecticut dry cleaners. DECD provides grants of up to \$300K for the environmental assessment and cleanup of eligible sites.

Note

This is a State of Connecticut funded program for which eligibility of the applicant and/or project will be determined upon completion of the application process.

Upon completion of this intake form, DECD will provide applicants with a notification of their place in line on the waiting list to receive funding as it becomes available. Prior to receiving funds, applicants will need to fill out a supplemental application form with further details on the proposed project.
